

GLOBEFUEL RELAUNCHES DRIVE INTO AVIATION MARKET

AS AFS, BP, SHELL FORM NEW JV

Hamburg, 28.07.2008 - Three leading players in the aviation fuel market today finalised a new ownership agreement for GlobeFuel (formerly owned by AFS), a leading provider of integrated IT systems for into-plane refuelling services. In a new joint venture, AFS, BP and Shell will each own a one-third share.

Under the new joint venture, GlobeFuel will continue to market its products with own access to the market and operate as a stand-alone entity with operational autonomy from its parents.

GlobeFuel's software products are designed to increase the efficiency of aircraft refuelling processes, in particular enabling the automated capture and transmission of information relating to aircraft refuelling.

GlobeFuel's fuel handling software currently supports the refuelling of aircraft at more than 350 airports around the world. With the backing of the new owners, the entirely new developed fuel handling software *PlanIT* will be launched in 2009 offering customers further technological efficiencies and cost-savings.

PlanIT is a software family on a modular and scalable platform that fits the needs of into-plane operators at all sizes of airports, from small airstrips to major international hubs. With its state-of-the-art technology *PlanIT* can be operated stand-alone or as an ASP application over the internet.
